I-20 (F-1) Application Form

READ CAREFULLY: Print clearly or type **all** required information on this form. Failure to do so will delay or prevent issuance of your I-20.

I-20s (also called F-1) must be completed on-line with SEVIS (Student Exchange Visitor Information System) by the issuing school to the INS (Immigration Naturalization Service). Please follow the steps below to register .

Step 1: Fill out and submit I-20 application with deposit amount of \$1,500.00.

Deposit will be credited to students International administrative fee and tuition account upon completion of the registration process. \$500.00 of the deposit is non-refundable. If the student is denied entrance by the school 100% of your deposit will be refunded. If the student is denied a VISA by the Embassy the refund amount of \$1,000.00 will be issued **with proof of the denial and a letter requesting a refund.**

Step 2: Fax current school academic records to 702-784-0192

Step 3: Fax or e-mail copies of letters of recommendation to school

- ◆ Pastor/Church
- ◆ School Administrator or Teacher
- ◆ Community member

Step 4: If admission is granted, Trinity prepares your I-20. Original I-20 is signed by SEVIS DSO or PDSO. Your I-20 along with a letter of acceptance can be sent out via express mail for a small fee, or you can have a local guardian pick up the I-20 in the office.

Step 5: After receiving your I-20 you will need to visit www.fmjfee.com and pay your VISA fee's prior to your appointment at the US Consulate in your country.

(Note: The I-20 must be approved by the INS office and Embassy before student can officially enroll)

Step 6: **Bring the official I-20 with original signatures back to the school as soon as student arrives.**
